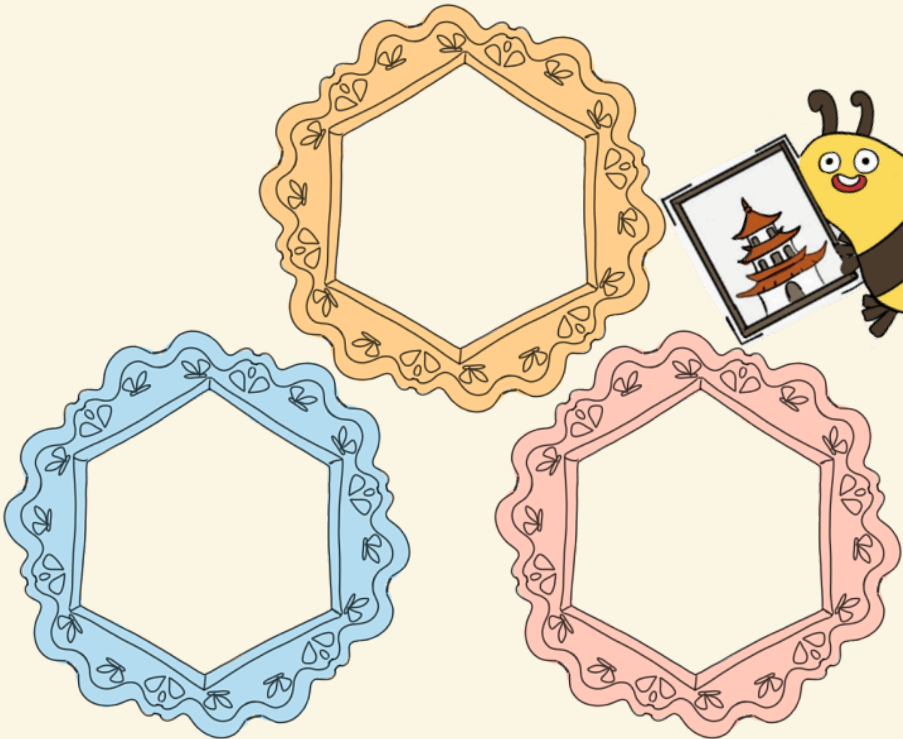
Trip Down Memory Lane

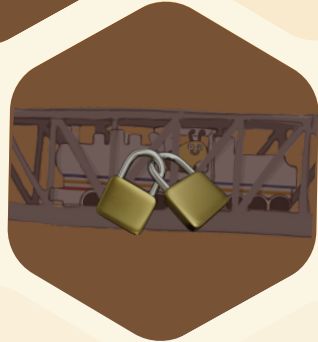

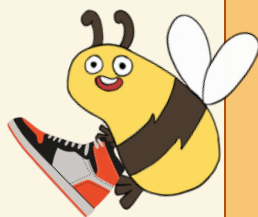

Mr Paul first learnt by watching other cobblers during his lunch breaks when he was working in the shipyard.



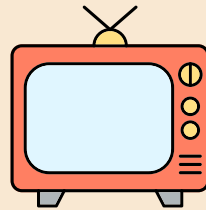
He bought materials to practise at home until he could do it successfully.

Mr Robin is now one of the last tailors in Clementi.

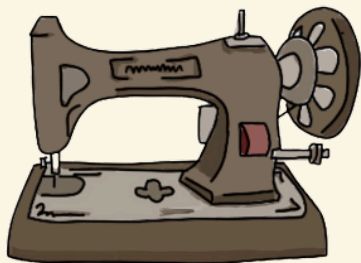
Even though many tailoring shops have closed because the work is demanding, he still loves what he does and wants to keep sewing for as long as he can.

His passion for tailoring and dedication keeps both his family tradition and this special craft alive!



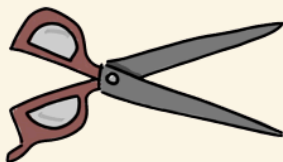

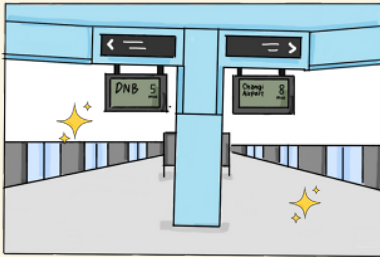
Now, we have the Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) instead! It began operations on 7 November 1987! Do you take the MRT frequently?

5.30AM

Check the communications log and confirm all equipment are functioning before starting train operations.



6.30AM

Walk around the station to check that everything is safe and secure (every 2 hours during operation hours).



7.30-9.30AM

Help manage crowds on the platforms during busy mornings and assist commuters, making sure the station is safe and runs smoothly.
